Need

With the implementation of #1401 it should be possible to create a page for squads (technical groups). This comes from a need to make it possible for a squad to get a holistic overview in regards to what the squad owns and has responsibility for.

Proposal



I think the most natural implementation would be to have it as an entity page for the group entity defined in #1401. Thus, the squad page can also be built with tabs in the same way as other entities. These tabs can be plugins or they can be categories in which there are different components belonging to plugins that can be inserted. I think I prefer the last one, which is similar to the vision for the overview page in the service entity. I think it would be an easy solution to reuse a lot of what has already been implemented for entity pages in general.

I imagine that it could be possible for each squad to customize their own overview page based on what they would like to see. Maybe this would be configured in the yaml file that contains the group entity, but I'm not quite sure how this should be implemented.

In addition, I think it should be possible to have your squad page as the "homepage" in Backstage, but I'm also not quite sure how that would be implemented.

Alternatives

An alternative could be something like what is shown in the Backstage demo of the internal Spotify project - but I don't have any idea how that would be implemented.

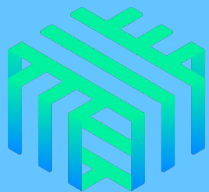

Bug Report

What is the issue?

I am trying to upgrade to 2.11.0 from 2.10.2. When upgrading the multi-cluster links I run into a duplicate definition error when applying the k8s manifests for the different links because the Server and ServerAuthorization has the same name for different links. I would expect the names of the objects to be prefixed or postfixed with the cluster name to avoid name clashes?

How can it be reproduced?

```
linkerd --kubeconfig$kubeconfig multicluster link --cluster-name link-one > link-one.yaml
